Challenges: Our stable food prices went very high if ones found it. We lost our head usherette. These and many other things slowed down some activities our Church. We have a feeding program for children in our community.

Progress: We have our regular services through the year in a building that is rented for \$400 per year which comes to an end this December 2022. This is a ministry that I really treasure and always make time for these kiddos. Every Saturday from 2 to 4 O'clock, we meet these kids to teach them the word of God and spend quality time with them. The 10 boys at M.H. and now the 10 girls really love it when I take them to Kids Club. It is a nice place for kids to learn the Word of God and also to be disciplined in life. We help teach them what their parents don't have time to teach them. They are really growing in their faith though.

We will have a week of activities next week like soccer championship, connect four contest, Christmas song contest, limbo contest etc.. And our Christmas party will be on December 24th and the boys and the girls at Mark's Home Orphanage will be fully participated with KCP in those activities. One of our goals was and still to feed them at least once a month and also being able to be more present in their lives as we know education and knowing Christ is truly what they need to be successful, but right now KCP is helping with only knowing Christ even if we have the intention to help some with the education as well, but we can't afford it now. We pray that God will provide. We meet with about 90 kids weekly and when we have big activities we always have over two hundreds kids. I cherish this ministry and it is something I love to do which is to be active in the lives of the little ones to influence them positively.

We love you all and are praying for all of you for everything you do for the kingdom. It wouldn't be the same without your support guys here on this difficult Island that is challenging us to push it harder daily. I and everyone here love and appreciate you all very much, keep up the good work. Please remember your labor is not in vain. A reminder in 1 Corinthians 15:58!!!!!!

The political unrest is still remaining the same; there is no major change as people continue to fight for position not for the people that voted for them. But, we are still alive and God never leave us nor forsake us. During this season of life, we learn many lessons such as: to rest in God's guidance, to be faithful to Him, to know that we are not in control and God is, to know that God is limitless while we are not, we learn to love and trust God in all circumstances of life, we learn to support each other, we learn to pray more and trust the word of God. We are always thankful to God for friends like you all who always pray and encourage us to take heart and keep moving no matter what.

First Christian Church (FCC)

Despite of the difficulties of 2022, FCC continues to grow. Even if things are difficult with the help of God, FCC continues to stay strong and united. Throughout the year we were able to organize some training for the kids, the youth, the adults, the families, the Sunday school teachers, deacons, and other leaders in the church.

FCC through a strategy we develop with the Sunday school classes' members, we were able to have them involve in about 1400 home visits. Through that same process, we were able to encourage members to sow the seed of the Good News to about 1755 individuals. The church was able to invade the street as a group to evangelize about 104 families. We baptized 6 new members into Christ. We have done about 4 baby dedications and also married three new couples. We have a gospel choir, an acapella choir and a worship band that began this year as well.

The church as a group was able to take the members to spend a half day in a swimming pool in the community which the members were really happy. We were able to go to a nice beach in Cap Haitian as well. All these activities to help build fellowship among the members, so that they can support each other in their faith in such a time as this. Many people are discouraged in Haiti at this time with kidnapping, violence, cost of living of all kinds. But we need your prayers and support through the process as the battle is both spiritual and economical. We believe and trust that God has the last words.

At FCC after the service, we always enjoy a fellowship moment with brethren by enjoying together some crackers and juice. We added a coffee with milk and bread time the first Sunday of each month.

I am so happy to share with you my yearly report for 2022. We the preachers, and co-workers visited 485 villages and prayed for 1675 families.

I am requesting you sister, please pray for our essential needs. I also need to buy a good camera for Ministry purposes. My computer display has gone and damaged badly. Please pray for me to get it repaired.

Pastor Babu Rao is the senior pastor in my Ministry. He is my coordinator and village ministry planner. He is serving Lord Jesus Christ for the past 25 years. He worked with my late father-in-law Sathya and my late brother-in-law Jaya Kumar. Now he is working with me continuously with great faith. During this year he served a lot for the Ministry.

Pastor Sudhakar is also a senior pastor working at GK Palli Church. G.K. Palli church building is an old construction and damaged very badly. Because of the continuous rains and floods, it is damaged. That this church building is on a low-level surface. Whenever heavy rains come, the church building is filled with rainwater. During the rainy season, it is very difficult to sit inside the building and problematic to do church service. We need to repair the church building. In 2022 he saved 22 souls from various villages and he conducted many village meetings also.

Pastor John is a 48-year-old senior pastor. He and his wife both are doing ministry work. They usually go every day to the villages and serve the Lord Jesus Christ. He is working in Vallivedu Church as a pastor. 30 members are gathering in the church building. It is an old church building and needs to repair inside of the church building. When the flood came, snakes and other poisonous creatures will come into the church building. The church members killed 5 snakes this year. I am requesting you please pray for this church building to get a repair.

Pastor Karunakar is a leper man and with the great love and affection of God he is saved from his sickness. After that, he chose to serve the Lord Jesus Christ. He has a wife and two children. He is working as a senior pastor at Akbar Nivas Kandriga church. Nearly 35 members will attend his church. Every Sunday his wife prepares food for the church members and his son has an auto rickshaw and he is bringing the church members in his auto. We need to extend the church building.

Pastor Yesudass, his wife, and his son are sincerely doing the ministry. They are faithful workers. Every Saturday they are visiting villages and deliver the word of God. Yesudas is a good evangelist. His church building was also damaged due to the heavy rains. Please pray for his church building.

Pastor Shantavardhan: He is doing church service since his teenage years. Now his age is 35 years.

Pastor David Paul: He is a bible teacher working in Periararam church building. Every Tuesday he is conducting one bible lecture on his church premises and spreads the bible knowledge to the young generations.
